v Thomas Gillespie

- a. Nature of the Abuse: The case involved here was against a fourteen year old boy, a parishioner of St. Bernard's Parish in St. Paul, who had biked out to visit Fr. Tom Gillespie in the summer of 1978, when Gillespie was pastor at St. Mary's in Stillwater. The description of the abuse by the plaintiff: "rubbing and simulated anal intercourse with ejaculation by Gillespie." Not clear whether with or without clothes.
- b. Date of the Abuse: The abuse occurred in the summer of 1978.
- c. Response of Gillespie: Gillespie admitted the abuse.
- d. Date on which SJA became aware of the abuse: 23 February 1996.
- e. Date of Settlement: May 1997.
- f. Response of SJA. Abbot Timothy removed Gillespie immediately from the parish at St. Joseph when he became aware in 1996 of the abuse that had occurred eighteen years earlier. The victim was offered counseling and the case was settled in May of 1997. Gillespie went for in-patient treatment at St. Luke's in Maryland. After treatment, Gillespie returned to the Abbey where he has no contact with young people. He has been working for physical plant doing computer graphics and signage since his return to the Abbey. The Abbey has no further allegations of sexual abuse against Gillespie.
